WHO SHOULD VISIT A TESTING CENTRE?

Persons with acute respiratory illness with a sudden onset of at least one of the following symptoms: cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, high fever (above 38°C measured)



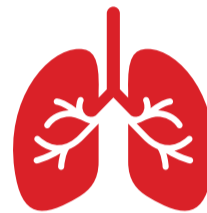
Cough

OR



Sore throat

OR



Short of breath

OR



High fever

AND

In the 14 days prior to onset of symptoms, met at least one of the following criteria:

Were in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of the Coronavirus (Covid-19) infection

OR

Had a history of travel to areas with presumed ongoing community transmission of the Coronavirus (Covid-19), i.e. Mainland China, South Korea, Singapore, Japan, Iran, Hong Kong and Italy

OR

Worked in, or attended a health care facility where patients with the Coronavirus (Covid-19) were being treated

OR

Admitted with severe pneumonia of unknown cause or origin

Phone your healthcare provider if you meet the criteria and suspect you may have COVID-19. Don't go to the GP's rooms without phoning in advance.
